**Lincoln Douglas Topic:** LD topics were discussed. The topic will be announced in March.

**Tournaments:** Future tournament, Pittsburgh, Arlington and Boston were discussed. The Executive Council examined bids received for the 2005 Grand National Tournament in preparation for presentation to the Executive Committee in May.

**Judging assignments:** League moderators are reminded that each change to a league's judging assignments after May 1st will be assessed a \$10.00 change fee per change. This fee is assessed to the local league and is payable on or before Friday registration for the NCFL Grand National Tournament.

Meeting adjourned and resumed Saturday morning.

**Registration Sheets:** The committee reviewed the registration sheets. Experience level will be added to the debate coaches' section on the registration sheet. C= 1-3 years, B= 4-9 years, A= 10+ years experience. A note will be added to registration instructions to remind moderators that judges who judge at nationals must have at least one year of experience judging in the general area to which they are judging: IE, Debate, LD, Congress.

**Changes to Congress sheets:** A congress judge can count toward the judging quota for a speech, but should be listed separately on the Congress sheet. Congress judges for the first day of competition who are not needed in the Congress will be released to the speech pool. If a judge is not qualified or experienced in speech please indicate this on the registration form.

The meeting was adjourned.
